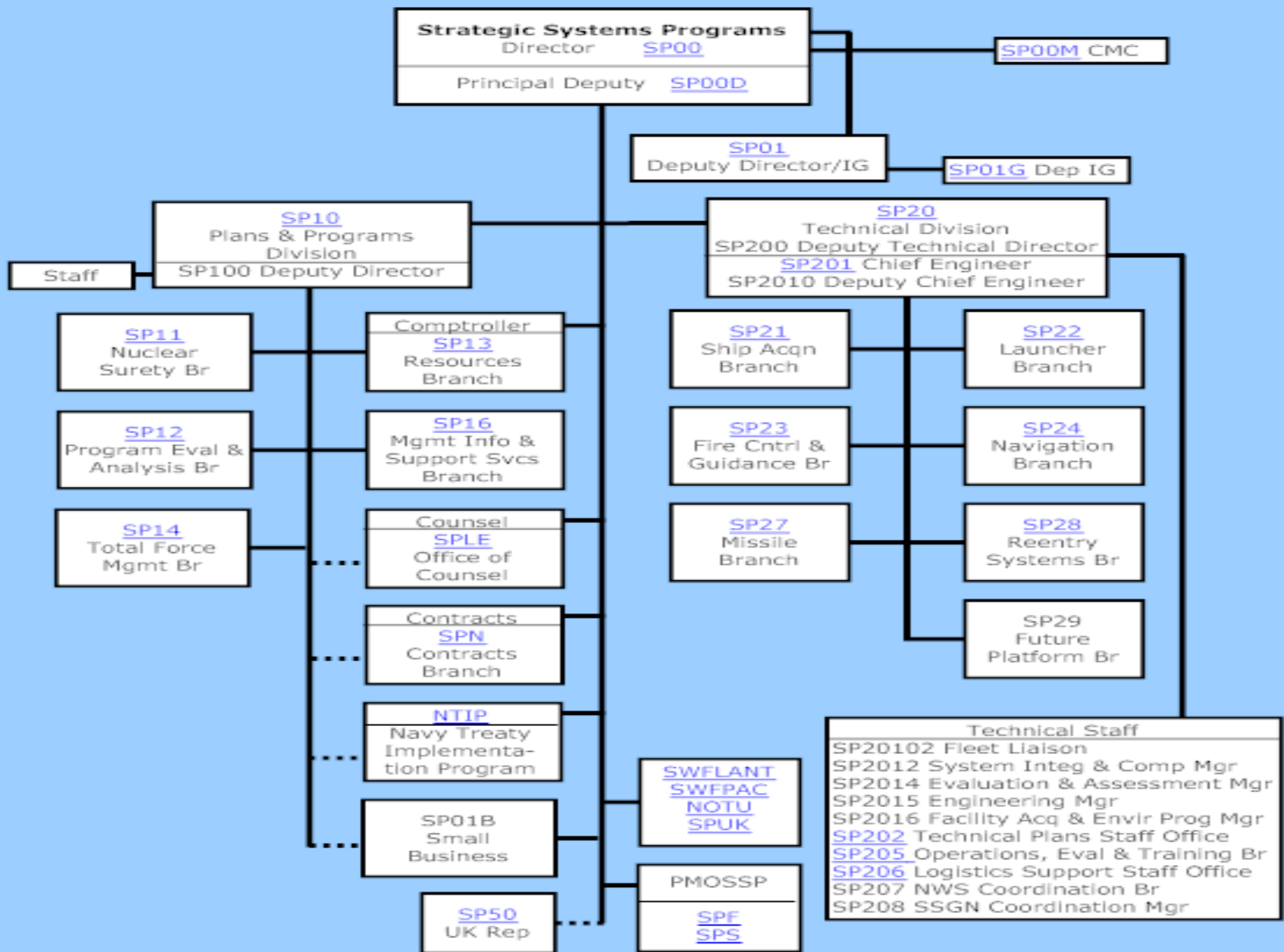


Strategic Systems Programs Mission and Requirements
